**A CAFOD Prayer for the Gift of Peace**

*May God give wisdom and courage to those who work for peace.  
We pray that their efforts may be blessed, that they may bring an end to violence

Last Saturday we were privileged (and ashamed?) to hear what ordinary lay folk can achieve.

Ben Rogers works for Christian Solidarity Worldwide, heading its East Asia team. He spoke particularly about Myanmar (and its Buddhist-led suppression of other religions), Indonesia (with its militant Muslims) and North Korea (where not one of the human rights enshrined in the UN Declaration is honoured).

In all these countries he seeks out and works with groups and individuals who champion universal human values. In Indonesia a young man who had been imprisoned for atheism was surprised to receive a visit from him. They found many beliefs in common. Anna Pincus, whose day job is with Gatwick Detainees Welfare Group and who started Refugee Tales, also founded Refugees Welcome in Crawley, which gives material assistance and support to refugees and liaises with the local authority and MP. She told us that over 34 thousand refugees are calculated to have died as a result of Fortress Europe, that in Hungary lawyers can now be arrested for advising refugees of their rights, and that a boy she is visiting in Brook House Detention Centre was incarcerated there 7 weeks ago after arriving here from Gambia, with a visitors' visa, to visit his brother, with whom he was due to stay. Because he brought little money with him the Immigration authorities deemed that he had come, illegally, to work. While he has been detained he has lost his job in Gambia and his mother has died of a stroke.

She urged us to be vigilant, to reflect, to speak out and to act, to march in protest, to write to our MP and of course to offer assistance to Refugees Welcome. Incidentally (though Anna did not mention this) they have so impressed the local euro-MP that he has secured a European award for their work.
